#### Political Communications

In January 2020 was approved the [National Artificial Intelligence strategy](#) which aims at improving the quality of public services through the use of digital and AI-related applications, among others.

#### Legislation

In April 2021, the Cypriot Parliament amended the Population Register law and of the Department of Electronic Communications law, with the aim of adopting the National eID Scheme.

#### Governance

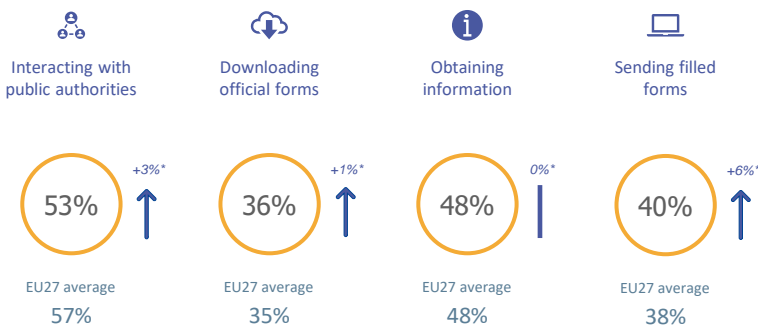
No recent changes in governance have been reported to date.

#### Infrastructure

The Deputy Ministry for Research, Innovation and Digital Policy adopted the “as-a-ServiceaaS” model (Infrastructure as a Service, Platform as a Service, Software as a Service) across the government.

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

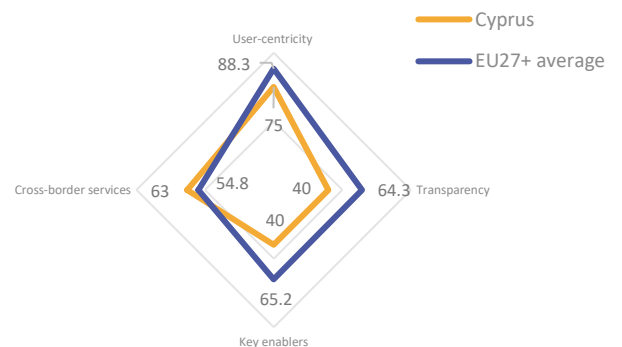

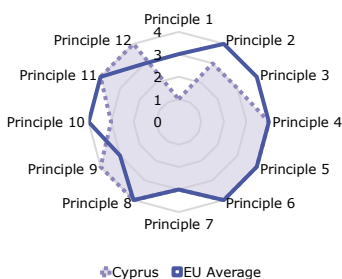
eGovernment performance across policy priorities



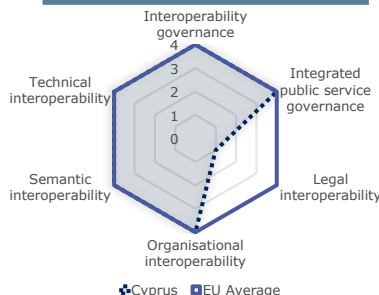

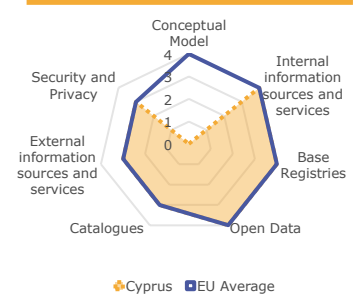
#### SCOREBOARD 1 TWELVE PRINCIPLES
